Service Yard Rules and Regulations

Please be environmentally conscious when working on your vessel, within or out of the water. We must all be aware of our environment and must take all necessary precautions to avoid polluting the water, air or ground.

Please use “common sense” and adhere to the following rules. This list may be changed and/or updated without prior notice.

1. A work order must be signed prior to hauling the vessel.
2. Owners wishing to do their own work shall read and acknowledge with a signature to this document.
3. Service yard customers are allowed 1 day free dockage prior to hauling and 1 day after launching. Also, 1 complementary day while on the hard. Charges of \$0.50 per foot per day will commence on the 2nd day of the haul. If vessel is to be dry greater than 14 days a dry storage contract shall be signed and the rate of \$7.50 per foot (\$6.50 slip holders) per month will be charged.
4. All payments due to YRYH for all services rendered are due upon receipt and will be paid in full before launching of vessel. YRYH accepts cash, checks and all major credit cards.
5. In the event of a change of ownership, YRYH shall be notified in writing by the owner, who remains responsible for all work and/or storage fees contracted and all further accumulating fees until a similar contract is signed by the new owner.
6. YRYH is not responsible for any damages to your vehicle or vessel while it is on the premises.
7. There is absolutely **NO PARKING** in the boat yard. After unloading your vehicle please park in the designated area along pier 8. Vehicles left parked in the service yard will be towed at the owner's expense.
8. Owner/skipper is responsible for ensuring lift slings are placed away from gear that could be damaged, i.e. propeller, propeller shaft, etc. YRYH is not responsible for sling damage.
9. All boat haul appointments must be on time. Failing to do so may result in possible re-booking.
10. YRYH is not responsible for any theft or loss of items left on or around the vessel or vehicle.
11. Only service yard staff may move boat stands. Do not under any circumstances adjust these stands yourself.
12. Outside contractors or employees of the owner are prohibited from performing any work on yachts in the service yard.
13. Bring your own OSHA approved ladder, hoses, grounded extension cords and tools. YRYH will not loan tools.
14. The raising of sails is strictly prohibited while the vessel is on blocks in the yard. No one shall ever go aloft while the boat is on yard property.
15. YRYH reserves the right to move or re-arrange any vessel without notice at any time.
16. 15 Amp electrical service is provided for your convenience while working on your boat daily. No unattended electrical use is permitted.
17. Sanding **must** be done with a vacuum collection system. The use of a small hand sander with an attached bag is NOT acceptable. Vacuum sanders are available for rent from the yard office at a rate of \$30.00 per half day and \$50.00 a full day.
18. All bottom scraping and sanding must have an approved cloth or tarp under the boat to catch bottom scrapings. Daily debris must be cleaned, bagged and placed in the trash.
19. All painting in the service yard will be confined to roller or brush painting only. Spray painting of any kind is prohibited.
20. Bottom painting must be performed by YRYH personnel, the boat owner or the boat owner's immediate family. All paints and other materials must be purchased at the ships store.
21. YRYH requests that all vessels keep their area clean. Failure to do so may delay your vessels launch and possibly a clean up fee.
22. Waste disposal methods:
 - a. Oil, gasoline, antifreeze, oil and fuel filters are recycled by YRYH. Please see yard management for proper disposal.
 - b. Bilge water cannot be pumped into the water or onto the ground. Use oil absorbent materials in the bilge. Bilge water must be pumped into approved containers for disposal.
 - c. Used batteries should be dropped off at the yard office for recycling.
 - d. Left over paint shall be removed by the owner or please give it to service yard personnel. Do not discard into dumpsters.
 - e. Empty paint and varnish cans, allow to dry completely. Dispose in regular dumpsters.
23. YRYH reserves the right to adjust its rates or modify the rules and regulations as deemed necessary. Any vessel in the service yard for work or storage at any time of a rate change becomes subject to those changes from the date of effect of the new rules.

I have read York River Yacht Haven's Rules and Regulations regarding the operation of the service yard and I agree to abide by these practices. I understand that I, personally, can be held financially responsible for any damages, both directly and indirectly resulting from my failure to abide by the above-mentioned practices.
